▶ State 4-H Congress/State 4-H Horse Championship Workshops & Training Opportunities

In the next couple of months, several workshops and training sessions for upcoming 4-H horse events and contests will be scheduled. Workshops/training sessions that will likely be held in late March through May will focus on Dairy Products Judging, Meats Judging, Horse Demonstrations, and other horse show-related topics. Even though we do not have a major horse show until June and July, there are still plenty of items to keep us busy.

▶4-H Club Congress Contests

4-H Club Congress Contests will be here soon (May 27–29). Now is the time to be lining up participation and planning county contests. Contests in the 4-H animal and dairy sciences area are Visual Presentations for seniors (four divisions included [1] beef; [2] sheep, swine, market goats; [3] dairy animals; [4] dairy products.) Other contests available are meats judging/identification contest, livestock bowl, and dairy bowl for senior members and dairy products judging. Plus there is a dairy poster contest with several age divisions. These are all excellent contests. If we can provide you with information about these contests, please let me know.

▶4-H District Project Achievement Day Contests

4-H District Project Achievement Day Contests will be here soon (June 9, 17-19). Now is the time to be lining up participation and planning county contests. Contests in the 4-H animal and dairy sciences area are Visual Presentations for juniors (two divisions included [1] beef, sheep, swine, market goats; [2] dairy animals, dairy goats, dairy products). The other contest is dairy products judging for juniors. The contests will be held as follows: June 9: SE Contests, Howard Technology Park, Ellisville; June 17: SW Contests, Hinds Community College, Raymond Campus; June 18: NW Contests, MS Delta Community College, Moorhead; and June 19: NE Contests, Itawamba Community College, Fulton.

▶ Pork, Beef & Poultry Cookout Contests

There will be a north- and south-half cookout contest for pork, beef and poultry. The contest dates and locations have not been determined at this time. Additional information will be sent from the State 4-H Office soon.

► Horse Judging Camp

The first Annual Horse Judging Camp will be held on July 8th-9th at MSU this year! The camp will be instructed by Dr. Clay Cavinder, the new State Horse Specialist (World and National Champion Collegiate Judging Team Coach and Professional Judge with AQHA, APHA, ApHC, NSBA, and NRHA). This year's camp will be open to both youth and adult coaches and leaders. Up-to-date industry instruction on halter and performance classes to further the education of youth, coaches, and adult leaders. This camp will be structured to advance both youth and adults who coach youth in horse judging. Additionally, instruction on reasons will be conducted. ▶ Alert Horse Project Members about Ownership & Ethics Certification!!!

NOTE: The 2015 Horse Show Rule Book is finished! When it is ready, we will let you know!

Remind your 4-H'ers and adult leaders that May 1st is the ownership deadline for horses to be shown in the 2015 4-H horse shows. Also, each horse showing in the district 4-H horse shows must be accompanied by original registration certificate or official ownership form for grade horses (BOTH DATED & SIGNED BY MAY 1ST). Copies of registration certificate or ownership form must be sent in with entries by district show deadline. Horses must be in the name of the 4-

H'er, or in the name of an immediate family member (farm name is not eligible). Also, any youth that wishes to show in this year's District and State 4-H Horse Shows must be a 4-H member by May 1st. The horse show entry deadline is May 1st.

In addition, a **NEW** 4-H'er who plans to show in the 2015 District & State 4-H Horse Shows and at least one parent must have completed the Horse Ethics Certification program by June 1st. Also, any **NEW** volunteers that assist 4-H'ers with their horses must be horse ethics certified by June 1st. **Be sure to comply with the recently released Registered Volunteer**Certification Process before certifying volunteers for horse ethics.

4-H'ers that are <u>only</u> competing in the non-riding contests (horse bowl, horse judging, art contest, photography contest, hippology, public speaking, and demonstration contests) do not have to be ethics certified. However, these 4-H'ers should be encouraged to be ethics certified!

An Official Negative Equine Infectious Anemia Test Certification or certified Coggins document (PHOTOCOPIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED) bearing lab number with animal identification issues within 12 months of the show date must accompany each horse in hand for all district and state 4-H horse shows. These certificates will be checked and must be in possession of the exhibitor and/or with the horse at the shows. If agent maintains original registration papers, agent MUST BE PRESENT at time of check in. Now is the time to be taking care of these important matters. Alert your 4-H'ers.

►Horse Bowl

Each county with teams is requested to submit 25 questions for juniors and 25 questions for seniors, regardless of the number of teams competing per county. These questions will be used in developing the district and state contests. **These questions must be sent via email to Dr. Dean Jousan (djousan@ads.msstate.edu) by April 1, 2015.** Questions and the correct answers must be typed, come from the official sources only and include reference source with page number.

▶4-H Dairy Poster Contest

The theme for the 2015 Dairy Poster Contest is "*Get More with Milk*". Publication 799 contains all the information about this contest and can be obtained from Extension Supply by electronic publication ordering from Department A9. Your winning poster in the three age divisions are to be delivered to a location to be determined on Wednesday, May 27th, the first day of State 4-H Club Congress for judging in the state contest. The deadline will be 11:30 a.m. Good Luck!

District and Dixie National Junior Round-Up premiums have been totaled and mailed to Jackson.

▶2015 DIXIE NATIONAL SALE OF JUNIOR CHAMPIONS

The 46th Sale of Junior Champions was another great event for our youth involved in the Mississippi 4-H Livestock Program. The Sale's committee is to be commended for the hard work that they put into this sale to make it a very successful activity. This was the 21st year in a row for the sale to gross over \$100,000. Gross total for the 43 animals sold for a **NEW SALE RECORD of \$382,595**. The 8 steers averaged \$12,511 per head; the 14 hogs averaged \$7,841 per head; the 12 lambs averaged \$7,114 per head; and the 9 goats averaged \$9,707 per head. The Grand Champion Steer was purchased by Blue Cross Blue Shield, Haley & Marsha Barbour, Ergon, Inc., and M.G. Dyess, Inc. for \$17,000. Gray-Daniels Ford and Watson Quality Ford purchased the Grand Champion Hog for \$9,000. Southern Ag Credit, Bank of Kilmichael, Glenwild Stockyards, Fancher Cattle Co., Mossy Oak Properties, Homefront Home Improvement Center, Hal & Linda Parker, Mark & Mary Shapley, Donald Timber, Lt. Gov. Tate Reeves, Speaker Phillip Gunn and Kipp Brown purchased the Grand Champion Lamb for \$7,000. The Grand Champion Goat was purchased by KLLM Transport Services, Stribling Equipment, Empire Trucks, Regions Bank and Southern States Utility Trailer Sales for \$5,000.

The Sale of Junior Champions continues to mean a lot to our Mississippi youth livestock program. The 46 sales have grossed a very impressive \$5,877,127.40. The first sale in 1970 had a gross total of \$7,621.35. This outstanding activity has come a long way in 46 years! In addition to the sale of champion animals, 35 scholarships were awarded totaling \$55,500. In the past 22 years, \$660,200 has been awarded to Mississippi youth to assist them with their college education.

The buyers, contributors, sale committee members, Extension staff members assisting with the sale, and other supporters who help make this a special event for our youth are to be commended.
