### **☑ 4-H Livestock Project Ideas**

During my time as the Extension 4-H Livestock Specialist, several 4-H leaders and Vo-Ag advisors approached me with ideas and suggestions on how to improve various 4-H Livestock Projects, and some even had ideas for new programs. If you have ideas and/or suggestions about 4-H Livestock Projects in your area, please email them to me or give me a call. I believe that there is an excellent group of 4-H agents throughout the state of Mississippi with fresh ideas in addition to those that I have, and together we can continue to make a difference in the lives of Mississippi 4-H'ers.

### **☑ State 4-H Congress/State 4-H Horse Championship Workshops & Training Opportunities**

In the next couple of months, I will be conducting several workshops and training sessions for upcoming 4-H livestock events and contests. More information and exact dates/times will be sent soon. Workshops/training sessions that will likely be held in late April and into May will focus on Oral Reasons, Dairy Products Judging, Meats Judging, and Horse Ethics with an update on new rules & regulations for the 2007 State 4-H Horse Championships. Preston and I are also working on having a distance education session about the Southern Regional Horse Show. Also, in late May or early June, I will organize a Horse Judging Workshop and will try to have a training session on topics related to Horse Demonstrations (Individual & Team) and Horse Public Speaking. Even though we do not have a major livestock show until July, there are still plenty of items to keep us busy.

### **☑ Volunteer Recognition**

As mentioned earlier, volunteer support is critical to the success of the 4-H Livestock Program. Many of these individuals are recognized throughout the year and at year-end County 4-H Banquets. I want to recognize these volunteers in the 4-H Animal Lines Newsletter as well. If you have outstanding volunteers that are deserving of being recognized for their efforts, write a short description of the service provided by these individuals and send a picture of them (if available) to me. In each Newsletter, I will add a section to recognize these outstanding volunteers.

### **☑ Story Time**

4-H Livestock Programs are fun and exciting for exhibitors, and I want to start another section in the 4-H Animal Lines Newsletter where 4-H'ers, 4-H agents and volunteers, Vo-Ag advisors, FFA members, or family members can write about their experiences with their livestock projects and what participating in the 4-H Livestock Program has meant to them. Being a former 4-H'er myself, I remember countless experiences that I had showing cattle and chickens, competing in Public Speaking and Team Demonstration contests, judging livestock, and keeping record books. This section is designed to publicize what the 4-H Livestock Program has meant to 4-H'ers and those that help them with these projects and can serve as a promotional activity for the 4-H Livestock Program too. These stories can be mailed or emailed to me, and please have the 4-H'er include their name, county, livestock project, and a short description of their experiences.

## **► RECRUITING NEW MEMBERS**

Spend some time promoting the 4-H animal and dairy science projects. This would be an excellent time to make personal contacts with potential project members, doing a news release or a radio program, having a county meeting, organizing livestock clubs, or whatever works for you.

## **► 4-H Club Congress Contests**

4-H district and 4-H Club Congress Contests will be here soon. Now is the time to be lining up participation and planning county contests. Contests in the 4-H animal and dairy sciences area are Visual Presentations for juniors (three divisions included [1] beef, sheep, swine, market goats; [2] horse; [3] dairy animals, dairy goats, dairy products) AND seniors (four divisions included [1] beef; [2] sheep, swine, market goats; [3] dairy animals; [4] dairy products.) Other contests available are meats judging/identification contest, meats bowl, and dairy bowl for senior members and dairy products judging for juniors and seniors. These are excellent contests. If we can provide you with information about these contests, please let me know.

## **► PORK, BEEF & POULTRY COOKOUT CONTESTS**

Again this year, we will have a north-half contest for pork, beef and poultry and a south-half contest for pork, beef and poultry. The contest for the north half of the state will be June 26<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:00 a.m. at the Montgomery Co. Coliseum in Montgomery County. The contest for the south half of the state will be June 27<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:00 a.m. at the Copiah Co. Multipurpose Building in Copiah County. If you need directions to these facilities, call the Montgomery and Copiah County Extension Offices. Additional information will be sent at a later date.

► **ALERT HORSE PROJECT MEMBERS ABOUT OWNERSHIP & ETHICS CERTIFICATION!!!**

**NOTE: The 2007 Horse Show Rulebook is close to being finished! When it is ready, we will let you know!**

Remind your 4-H'ers and adult leaders that May 1<sup>st</sup> is ownership deadline for horses to be shown in the 2007 4-H horse shows. Also, each horse showing in the district 4-H horse shows must be accompanied by original registration certificate or official ownership form for grade horses (**BOTH DATED & SIGNED BY MAY 1<sup>ST</sup>**). Copies of registration certificate or ownership form must also be sent in with entries by district show deadline. Horses must be in the name of the 4-H'er, or in the name of an immediate family member (farm name is not eligible). Also, any youth that wishes to show in this year's District and State 4-H Horse Shows must be a 4-H member by May 1<sup>st</sup>.

In addition, remind your 4-H'ers, parents and volunteers that all 4-H'ers who plan to show in the 2007 District & State 4-H Horse Shows and at least one parent must have completed the Ethics Certification program by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Also, any volunteers that assist 4-H'ers with their horses must be ethics certified by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

4-H'ers that are **only** competing in the non-riding contests (horse bowl, horse judging, art contest, photography contest, hippology, public speaking, and demonstration contests) do not have to be ethics certified. However, these 4-H'ers should be encouraged to be ethics certified!

An **official certificate** showing a current (good for one year) negative Coggins test will be required on all horses that show in district and state 4-H horse shows. These certificates will be checked and must be in possession of the exhibitor and/or with the horse at the shows. Exhibitors must also present ORIGINAL (no copy of original) registration papers at the district and state shows. If agent maintains original registration papers, agent MUST BE PRESENT at time of check in. Now is the time to be taking care of these important matters. Alert your 4-H'ers.

► **HORSE BOWL QUESTIONS**

Each county with teams is requested to submit 25 questions for juniors and 25 questions for seniors, regardless of the number of teams competing per county. These questions will be used in developing the district and state contests. These questions must be sent to Dr. Dean Jousan in the ADS Department (Box 9815, Mississippi State, MS 39762) by May 1, 2007. Questions and the correct answers must be typed on white 8½ X 11 paper, must come from the official sources only, and must include reference source with page number.

► **4-H DAIRY POSTER CONTEST**

The theme for the 2007 Dairy Poster Contest is *"Got Flavored Milk"*. Publication 799 contains all the information about this contest and it will be obtained from Extension Supply by electronic publication ordering from Department A9. **(Will send an e-mail when P799 is available.)** Your county winners in the three age divisions are to be delivered to the Bost Extension Center "B" on Tuesday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, the first day of State 4-H Club Congress for judging in the state contest. The deadline will be 11:30 a.m. Good Luck!

► **2007 DIXIE NATIONAL SALE OF JUNIOR CHAMPIONS**

The 38<sup>th</sup> Sale of Junior Champions was another great event for our youth involved in the Animal and Dairy Sciences Program. The Sale's committee is to be commended for the hard work that they put into this sale to make it a very successful activity. This was the 13<sup>th</sup> year in a row for the sale to gross over \$100,000. Gross total for the 38 animals sold was \$279,008.50. The nine steers averaged \$9.44/lb.; the thirteen hogs averaged \$23.85/lb.; the thirteen lambs averaged \$35.69/lb.; and the three goats averaged \$52.00/lb. The Grand Champion Steer was purchased by Ergon, Blue Cross/Blue Shield of MS, and Governor Haley & Marsha Barbour for \$17.00/lb. for a total of \$22,916 and was the highest selling animal in the sale. Wilson's Meat House purchased the Grand Champion Hog for \$25.00/lb., for a total of \$6,425. Brookshire's Grocery and Regions/AmSouth Bank purchased the Grand Champion Lamb for a new record price of \$60.00/lb. for a total of \$9,060. The Grand Champion Goat, which was purchased by Direct General Insurance, Co., Bobby & Barbara Martin, Cary & Mary Childs, and Bob & Amber Lee Glover for a new record price of \$80.00/lb. for a total of \$7,200.

The Sale of Junior Champions continues to mean a lot to our Mississippi youth livestock program. The 38 sales have grossed a very impressive \$3,501,138.35. The first sale in 1970 had a gross total of \$7,621.35. This outstanding activity has come a long way in 38 years!

The buyers, contributors, sale committee members, Extension staff members assisting with the sale, and other supporters who help make this a special event for our youth are to be commended.
