- 1. Open the Mississippi MarketMaker home page and locate the Market Research tab on the Left hand Side of the page
- 2. Click the first drop down tab and select 'Food Preferences'.
- **3.** Select "Average Dinner Away from Home Expenditures" in the Subtype dropdown menu and select the Search tab.
- **4.** A map of the results will be displayed along with a chart showing the data. You may then select a different state or county. For this example, Jackson County was used as shown below.
