Limited Oyster Season Opens!

The Mississippi oyster industry consists of the harvesting, processing, wholesaling and retailing sectors. The entire industry generated total sales impacts amounting to \$24 million and provided jobs to more than 550 workers.



Originally set for September 30, the opening of several oyster reefs for commercial tonging was delayed due to heavy rain. Reefs are set to open for commercial dredging on October 14, 2013.
