4-H VISUAL PRESENTATION & CLOVERLEAF EXHIBIT CONTESTS

The 4-H Visual Presentation & Cloverleaf Exhibit Contests will be held **Saturday, March 1**, at **10:00 A.M.** in the MSU Extension Exhibit Hall.

The Visual Presentation Contest consists of a demonstrated talk. Therefore, you can dress the part and use visual aides. You <u>MUST</u> have at least one poster unless you are using power-point. You can **not** use live animals or firearms for your demonstration, but you can use a picture. Extension Publication 1096, *How to Do a Visual Presentation*, can be found online or picked up at the Extension office.



PowerPoint presentations are encouraged and can be used for junior and senior members, but you should have a back up just in case of technological difficulties. A five-point penalty will be applied to any visual that is less than 3 minutes or exceeds 10 minutes.

Age Categories include: Junior I - Ages 10 & 11, Junior II - Ages 12 & 13, and Senior - Ages 14-18

Youth ages 5-9 can participate in the Cloverleaf Exhibit, rather than the visual presentation contest. The Cloverleaf exhibit consists of an exhibit related to the 4-Her's project and an interview by the judges. The exhibit must be made or produced by the 4-H member and relate to his or her 4-H project. An exhibit should consist of a title sign displayed on the front of the table or set on the top of the table along with materials related to the project. 4-H members should be knowledgeable about their 4-H project. STORY BOARDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Please do not use your reading or science fair project board. Publication 1653, Participating in the Mississippi 4-H Cloveleaf Exhibit, is available online or may be picked up at the Extension office.

Please contact the office if you have any questions regarding these contests. **Be sure to sign up by 5:00 p.m. Monday, February 24.** We need at least 10 registered to offer these contests.

2025 MS 4-H Wildlife Art & Photography Contest

Do you love creating art and/or photography? If so, the MS 4-H Wildlife Art & Photography Contest is a great opportunity for you to showcase your talents.



Art Categories include:

Pastels/Charcoal/Graphite/Colored Pencil (Abstract or Realistic), Oil/Acrylic/Watercolor (Abstract or Realistic), Pen/Ink/Markers/Crayon (Abstract or Realistic), Cartoon, Sculpture/3-D, and Mixed/Altered Media.

Photography Categories are:

Action, Non-Action, Human Interest. (Digital Only) Photos should be 5" x 7" format in plastic sleeve.

Age divisions: 8-13 years old, 14-18 years old

The top three entries in each category from each District go on to be judged on the State Level. Entries from each of the top three entries in the State will be displayed at the Mississippi Wildlife Exposition in late summer.

We need your help to design the 2025 Annalisa Laudadio Love & Encouragement 5K t-shirt. This contest is open to youth and adults.

Contest rules and conditions:

A replica of the winning design will be featured on the race T-shirt.

Entries should be submitted on white, unlined, letter sized (8 1/2" x 11") paper.

- Designs can be original artwork or computer generated. Only two-dimensional designs will be accepted.
- Color designs are encouraged but please limit the artwork to three colors. The design may not be printed in the exact colors on the T-shirt.
- When using the 4-H Clover, the emblem must adhere to the rules outlined in the 4-H National Headquarters Fact Sheet: Using the 4-H Name and Emblem.
- The 4-H T-Shirt Design selection committee reserves the right to modify the winning design.
- The selection committee will review all entries and will choose the best design based on creativity, originality, and uniqueness.
- Include your first and last name and phone number on the back of the design.

The winner will receive a free 5K t-shirt and their choice of a free 5K entry or a \$20 prize. **The entry dead-line is** <u>Tuesday, April 15, 2025</u>.
