




Summer Camps




or 2:30-3:30 p.m. Specify which time you will attend when you register. The program will cost \$5 per youth to attend.



Yarn Dyeing and Design Camp will be June 27th and 28th, 2:00 - 4:30 p.m. at the Bolivar County Extension Office for youth 10-15 years old. Deadline to register will be June 15th. The class will cost \$10 per youth and they need to bring clothes to wear while dyeing the yarn. We have a minimum of five to hold the class. Manners Class will be July 10th and 11th from 10:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. This day camp is for youth 8-13 years old. The camp will be \$5 per person.
